
# **KCATA** | **Ride**KC

The Kansas City Area Transportation Authority (KCATA) is sharing this potential service adjustment information. This is NOT FINAL, but due to the process necessary to implement changes it is necessary that we begin to get public feedback. KCATA is working to identify additional funding that may change this initial list of adjustments. Proposed service reductions are a result of the increased cost of providing public transit in the post- COVID years and the depletion of federal pandemic funds.

### **Additional Changes to Note**

- Hours of operation have been changed so that no service starts before 5:00am and no service ends after 11:00pm. This change affects Weekday and Weekend service.
- Weekend service with frequency better than 30 minutes will be reduced to 30 minutes.
- All Weekend service will be eliminated except for the following routes: 1 Main MAX, 2 Troost MAX, 3 Prospect MAX, 24

Independence, 31 31st Street, 101 State Avenue, and 201 North Oak. These routes will operate at 30-minute frequency on weekends.

 On weekdays, non-peak frequency will be reduced for the following routes: 1 Main MAX, 2 Troost MAX, 3 Prospect MAX, and 24 Independence. These routes will operate at 15-20 minute frequency from 6am to 6pm. Outside of this peak window, these routes will run at 30-minute frequency.
